The Rules of Golf and golf etiquette as established by the United States Golf Association 2019 will govern all play at Laurel Oak Country Club, except as modified by the following:

LOCAL RULES

• Drop Areas - Are in use at all times, unless tournament rules state otherwise Jones Course- Holes #2, #6, #7, #8, #10, #14, #16 and #18. Player Course - Holes #5, 6 and 12.

Back drop zone for players playing Black, Gold Green & Blue tees Forward drop zone for players playing Silver, Yellow, Red tees

- The Short Game Area to the left of lones Course hole #18 has been marked with red stakes with green tops as an Environmental Sensitive Area (ESA). Players must take a mandatory drop in the drop zone provided, with a penalty shot of one stroke.
- Sprinkler Head Rule A sprinkler head close to the putting green is an immovable obstruction. A player is allowed relief without penalty from a sprinkler head if it interferes with stance or swing or it interferes with his line and (1) the ball is within two club lengths of the sprinkler head and (2) the sprinkler head is within two club lengths of the green. (Rule 16.1a).
- Out of Bounds White stakes designate out of bounds. The golf course edge of sidewalks defines the O.B. line (Hole #3 Jones - inside paved road edge). All fences and walls bordering the golf course are boundary fences The concrete staging area, practice facility and cart path behind #18 Player define the boundary - no relief is granted. Any ball coming to rest on the homeowners' side of any penalty area is out of bounds (Rule 18.2). Alternative to Stroke & Distance rule is in effect allowing a golfer the option to drop a ball in the vicinity of where the ball is lost or out of bounds (including nearest fairway) under a two stroke penalty.
- Ground Under Repair- Painted white lines designate ground under repair (Rule 16.1). General Area: Balls coming to rest on the green edge for encroachment can be lift clean & placed to nearest point of relief not closer to the hole. Play all tire tracks/ ruts as ground under repair.
- The Embedded Ball Rule is in effect in the general area (Rule 16.3).
- Staked Trees. Newly Sodded Areas. Ant Hills and Flower Beds as outlined below "Free" relief is permitted with no penalty in accordance with the Rules of Golf. Nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, plus one club length (Rule 16.1)
- Only flower beds on: Player Hole #1 behind green, behind Player #1 tee & 9 green and flower bed left of #17 player apply.
- Mulched Areas are considered an integral part of the golf course no relief is granted. • Waste Areas - Coguina shell based areas are considered waste areas - you may
- ground your club. All other sand based areas are played as bunkers.
- Bulkheads and Bridges are an integral part of the golf course and are marked as part of the penalty area. Play the ball as it lies or take relief in accordance with Rule 17.1.

COURSE GUIDELINES:

- Please observe 90 degree rule with carts unless otherwise posted. Carts must be kept at least 30 feet from tees, bunkers, mounds and greens. Carts must remain on the paths on par 3s.
- Please repair all ball marks, rake bunkers and fill divots with sand.
- All yardages are measured to the center of the green.
- Pace of Play 4 hours or less is an acceptable pace of play for a foursome. Each group must maintain their position with the group ahead. Please allow faster players to play through.
- Lightning Warning Procedure:
 - One long siren blast = play is suspended immediately please seek shelter.
- Intermittent hi-lo tone = resume play.
- The lake between #10 and #18 Jones and the lake between #5 and #7 Player course store reclaimed non-potable water for golf course irrigation.
